

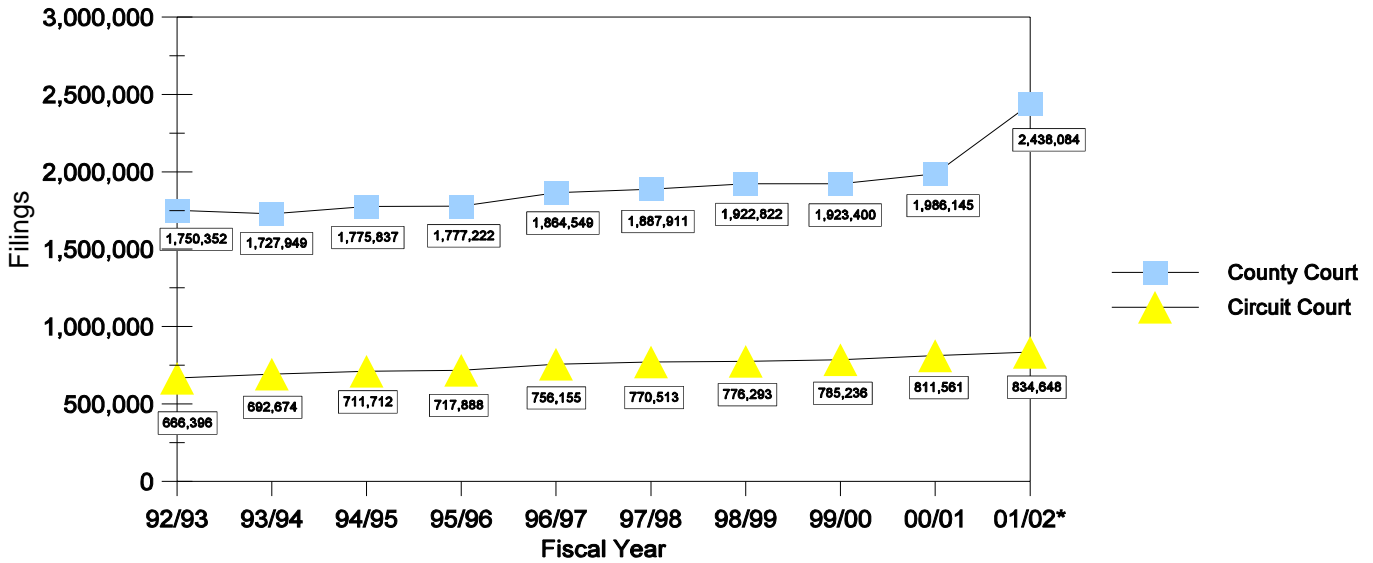
Overall Statistics

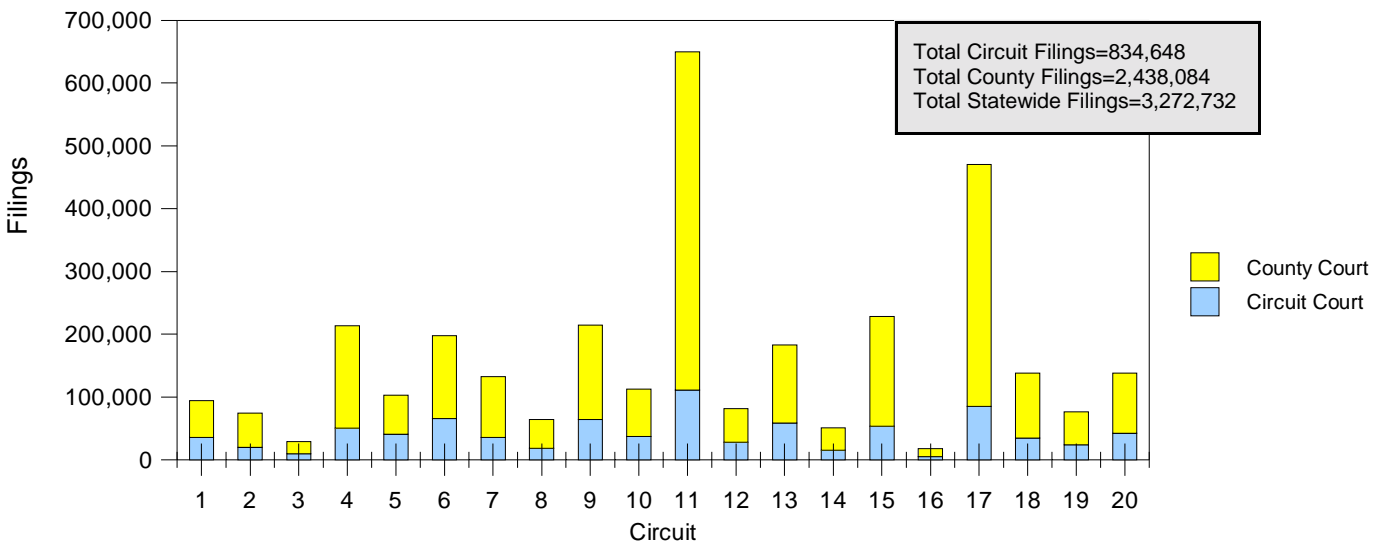

Circuit and County Court Filings by Circuit for FY 2001-02

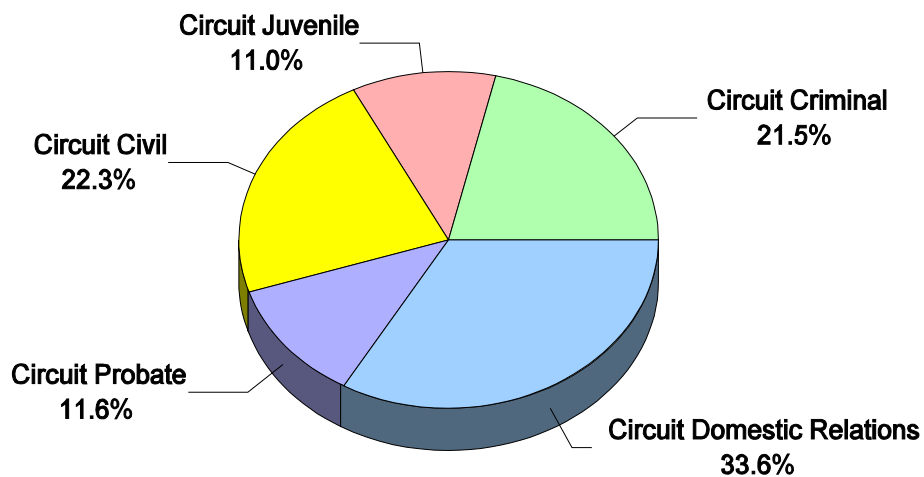

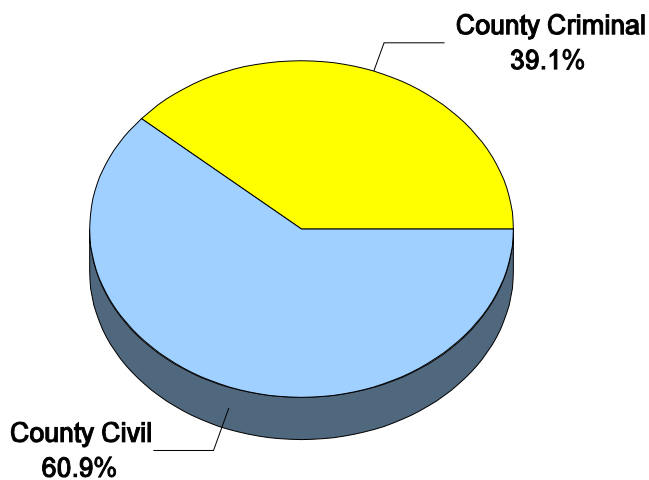

by Division for FY 2001-02

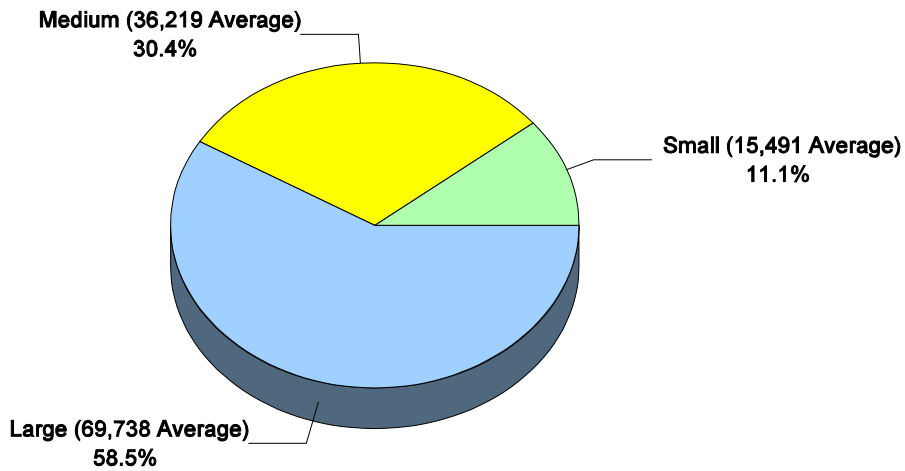


County Court Filings
by Division for FY 2001-02



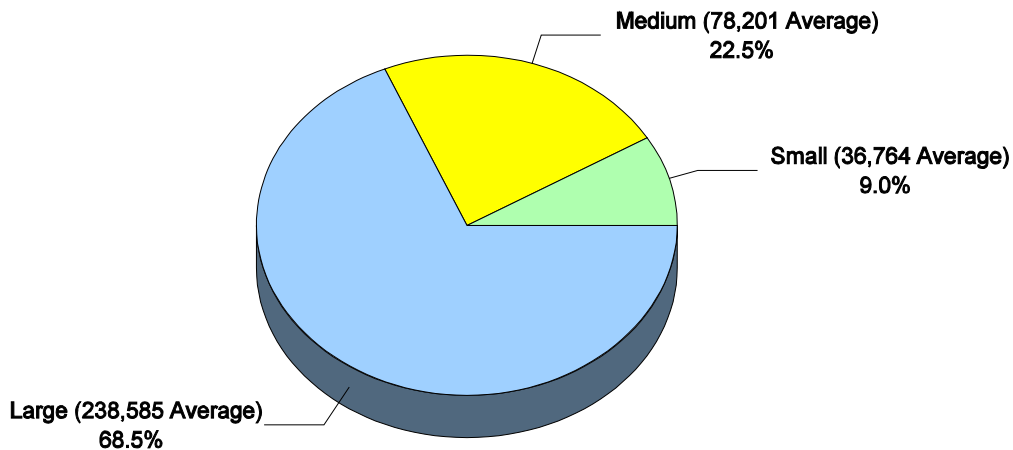
Circuit Court Filings by Circuit Size*

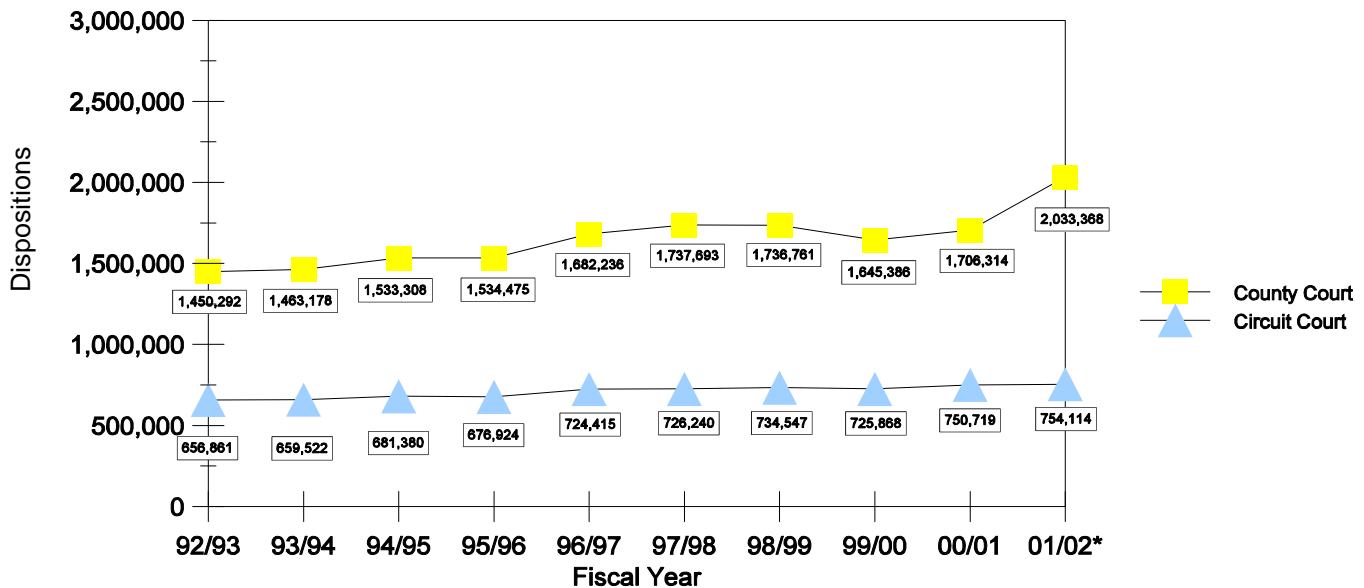

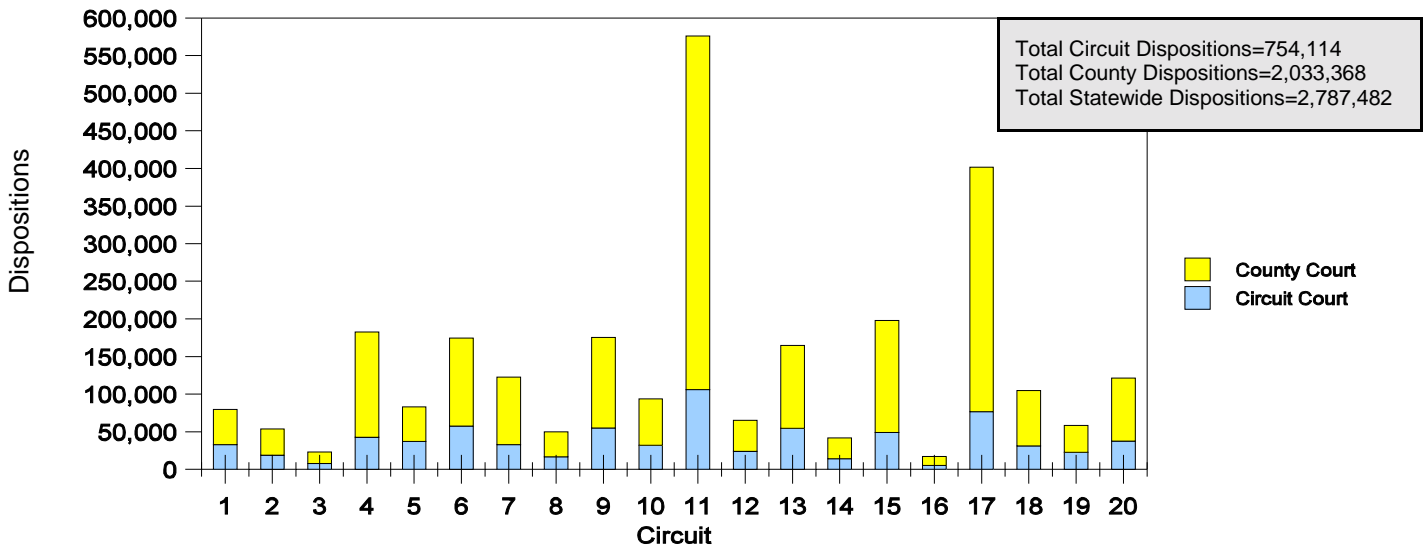
FY 1992-93 to FY 2001-02*

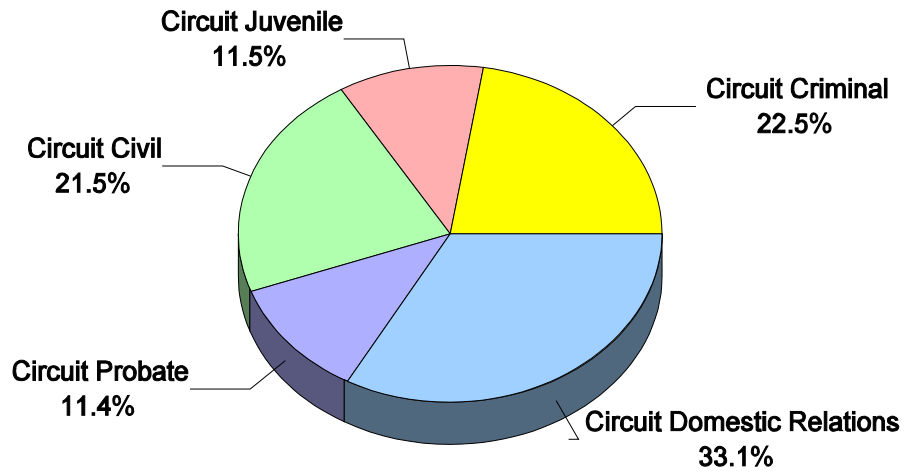

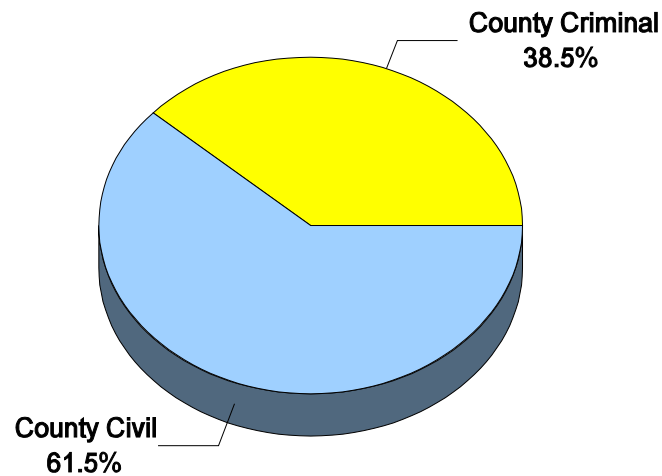
Circuit Court Dispositions

by Division for FY 2001-02



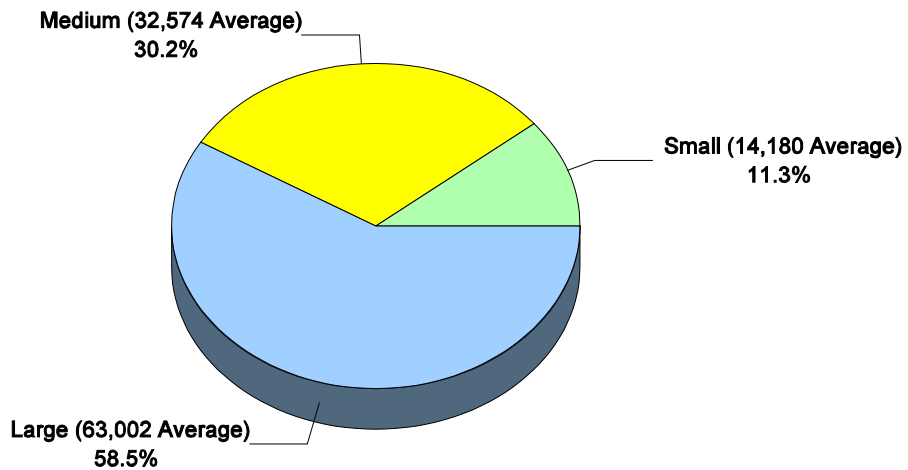
County Court Dispositions

by Division for FY 2001-02



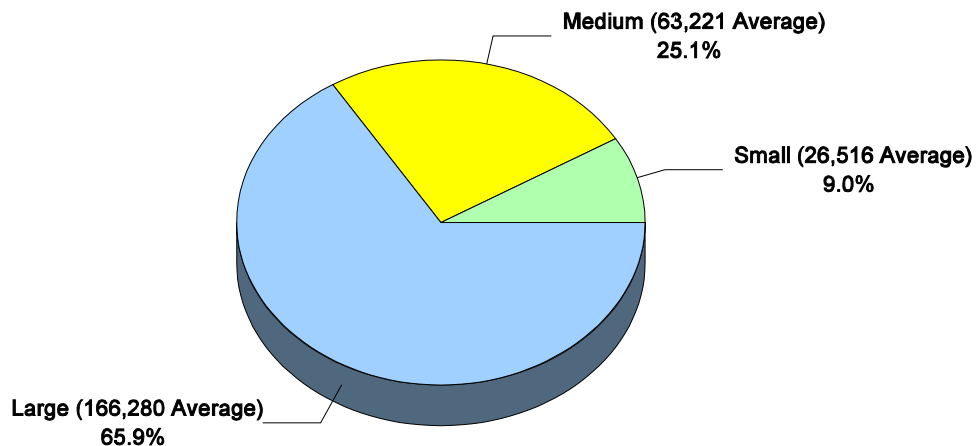
Circuit Court Dispositions by Circuit Size*
