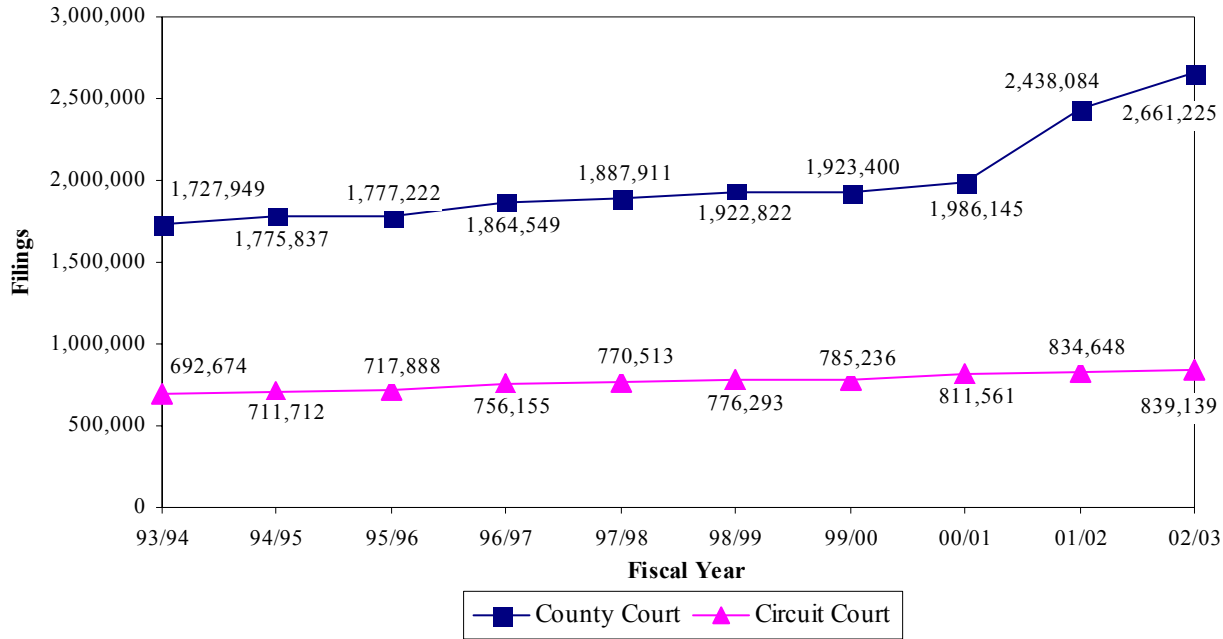

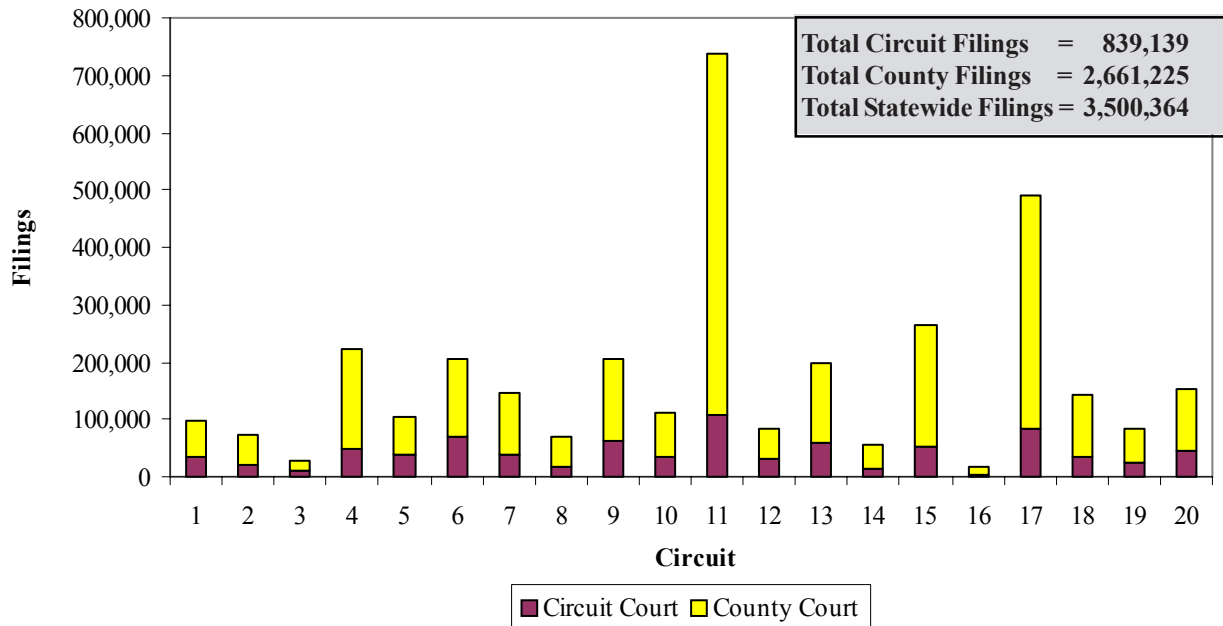
FY 1993-94 to FY 2002-03

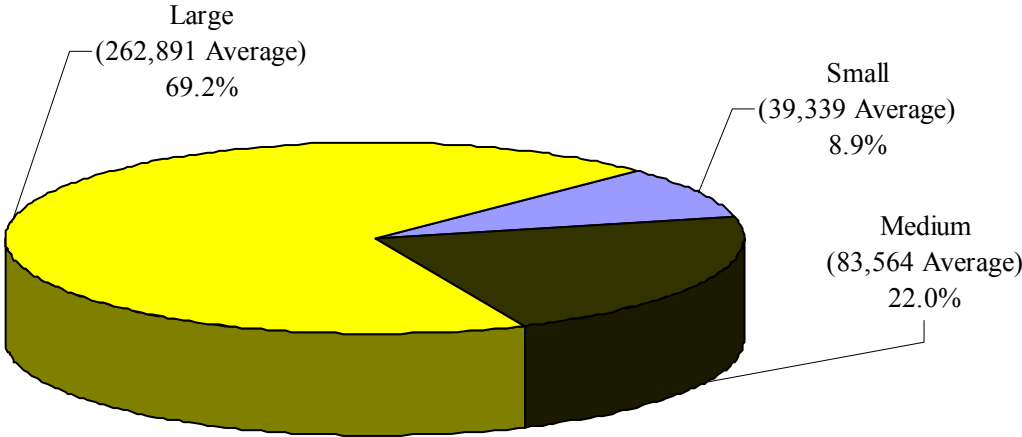

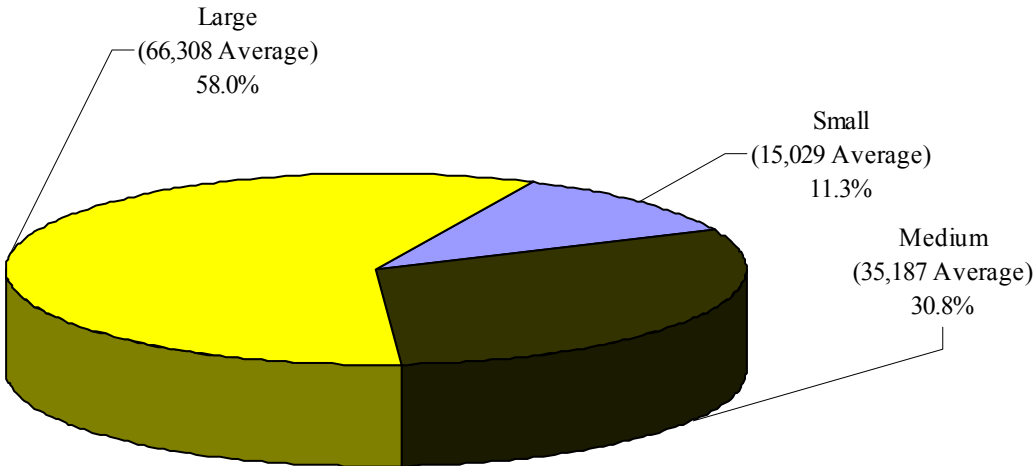

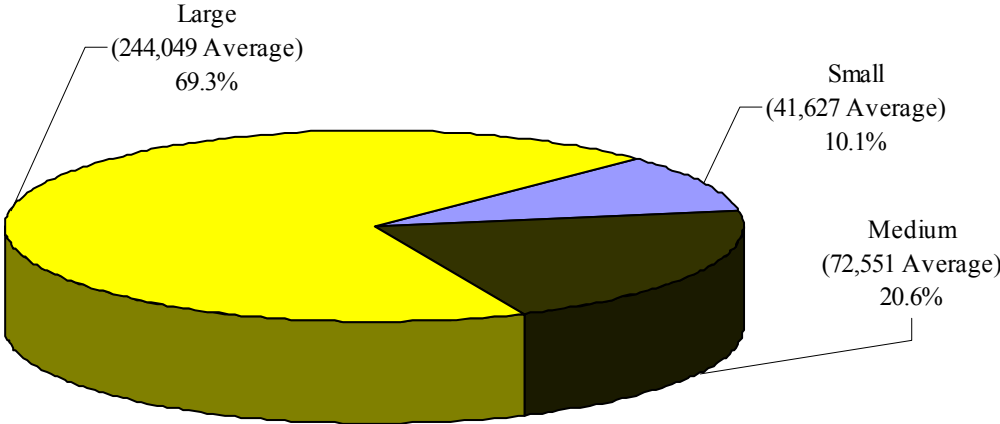
