Dear Mr. Hall:

The purpose of this letter is to inform the Court that, on January 31, 2008, the Florida Courts Technology Commission (FCTC) reviewed the recommendation made by the Electronic Filing Committee to approve a request from the Twelfth Judicial Circuit. This request was twofold:

- (1) To adopt the use of the Slash S (/s) electronic signature method for all electronic attorney filers in Manatee and Sarasota Counties; and,
- (2) For permission to expand the JudgeSign program which provides a facsimile signature on e-documents for the judiciary (currently running in Sarasota County) into Manatee County.

The use of the electronic signature method Slash S and facsimile signatures are categorized as low complexity requests. Based on the Supreme Court approval of September 5, 2007, all low complexity submissions can be approved by the Florida Courts Technology Commission without additional review by the Supreme Court.

Therefore, on behalf of the Florida Courts Technology Commission, I am herewith advising that the request made by the Twelfth Judicial Circuit is approved. This approval is subject to compliance with the terms and conditions as outlined in AOSC07-63 (attached).
