Mass Tort Curriculum for State and Federal Judges: An Online Resource

Under a grant from the State Justice Institute (SJI-01-N-063) the National Center for State Courts, in collaboration with the Conference of Chief Justices, is pleased to provide judges access to an On-line Bench book on Mass Tort Litigation. The course or bench book was created using "Blackboard" instructional software and requires users to create an account prior to accessing the course. The advantage to this process is the program is also attempting to track "best practices" in the area of collaboration between state and federal judges and only by the creation of an account and enrolling in the course will we be able to collect user feedback.

To access the course, click on the following hyperlink Blackboard.com. Follow the Blackboard instructions to create an account. Your username and password will need to be unique and remember able. For example as a username type your first names first two initial in conjunction with your last name (kewagner) and any password you will remember (dog). When you are done, login using your username and password. Next you will need to find the course - click on the "find a course" label to the right - at the key word search type in "Mass Tort Curriculum" and mouse click on the "go" button. Enroll in the course by clicking on the enroll button. You will be prompted for an access code - type in "masstort" and click on submit. You should now be able to navigate through the course.
