ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

The Honorable James E. C. Perry was appointed to the Supreme Court of Florida, thereby completing his service on the Trial Court Budget Commission.


The following individual is appointed to complete the remainder of Justice Perry's term on the Commission, which expires on November 30, 2010:
