The clearance rate has a reasonable ease of calculation, is a useful measure of the responsiveness of a court to the demand for services, and is nationally recognized as a measure of court performance.
3. Columns labeled as "Approved Standards" provide the final legislatively approved figures for the budget year identified.
4. The "Requested FY 2009-10" column corresponds to the official Judicial Branch Legislative Budget Request for FY 2009-10 and does not represent a goal for the court. It is simply an estimate of the amount of activity expected to occur during FY 2009-10.
5. The "Requested FY 2009-10" clearance rates are set at 100%.
