**MODERATE COMPLEXITY:** Submissions that are defined as Moderate complexity are formal electronic filing systems which: a) includes the electronic receipt and storage of the .PDF document; b) may include the submission of a pre-formatted cover sheet; c) the cover sheet may include eXtensible Markup Language (.XML), which is the standard language to ensure that the data incorporated in the cover sheet form can be manipulated or extracted for use in another application, such as a case management system; and d) provides the option to eliminate paper filing submissions.

**HIGH COMPLEXITY:** Submissions that are defined as High complexity are systems that may include the components of both the Low and Moderate complexity levels noted above, but it also involves a third party service provider. There may also be a service charge payable to the vendor and/or clerk. These systems include embedded "tagged" (.XML) information in the electronic filing submission which is used to populate case management or other automated systems.
