

Interpersonal Violence Injunctions (DV, SV, Dating, Repeat, Stalking) Case Law

Florida Supreme Court

In re: Amendments to Florida Family Law Rules of Procedure, ___ So. 3d ___, 2017 WL 1031456 (Fla. 2017). The Court adopted several rule amendments and created a stand-alone set of Family Law Rules of Procedure. Amongst other changes, the Court amended the rules to add a new subdivision that addresses the verification of documents, as well as a new subdivision that incorporates the provisions of Fla. Rule of Civil P. 1.210 regarding the appointment of the guardian ad litem or attorney ad litem for a minor. Further, the Court amended rule 12.270 by replacing a provision that states that related cases and consolidation of cases is governed by Fla. R. of Jud. Admin. 2.545. The Court declined to adopt changes suggested to the domestic violence forms.
