Zapiola v. Kordecki, __ So. 3d __, 2017 WL 535398 (Fla. 2d DCA 2017). **DOMESTIC VIOLENCE INJUNCTION REVERSED**. The petitioner was granted an injunction for protection against domestic violence after she alleged that her girlfriend threw a drink at her, punched her, and could use her job to hurt her in the future. The respondent appealed, claiming that the physical violence only happened once several years ago, and that she had never threatened the petitioner since. Because the allegations referring to the respondent's work were vague and did not show that the petitioner was in imminent danger, or that she had been threatened, the appellate court reversed the injunction.
