Analytical Products

This state-level information system will provide the following workload and performance statistics as defined in rules of court or statute and consistent with the court system's strategic goals (1.3, 4.4):

- Number of filings by division of court and case type for each circuit and statewide
- Number of dispositions by division of court and case type for each circuit and statewide
- Clearance rates by circuit, division, and judge
- Average time to disposition by circuit, division, and judge
- Number of active pending cases by circuit, division, and judge
- Average age of active pending cases by circuit, division, and judge

Searchable

The system will be searchable for the workload and performance statistics identified on the dimensions of judge, division, and circuit. Additionally, the system will also provide search capability on the specific data underlying these statistics.

Accessible

The statistics generated will be accessible to all trial court judges, appellate court judges, supreme court justices, and other authorized staff of the courts. At this time, the system will not be available to persons outside the court system. However, as always, reports will be available to the public via the Research and Statistics subunit of Court Services by request.
