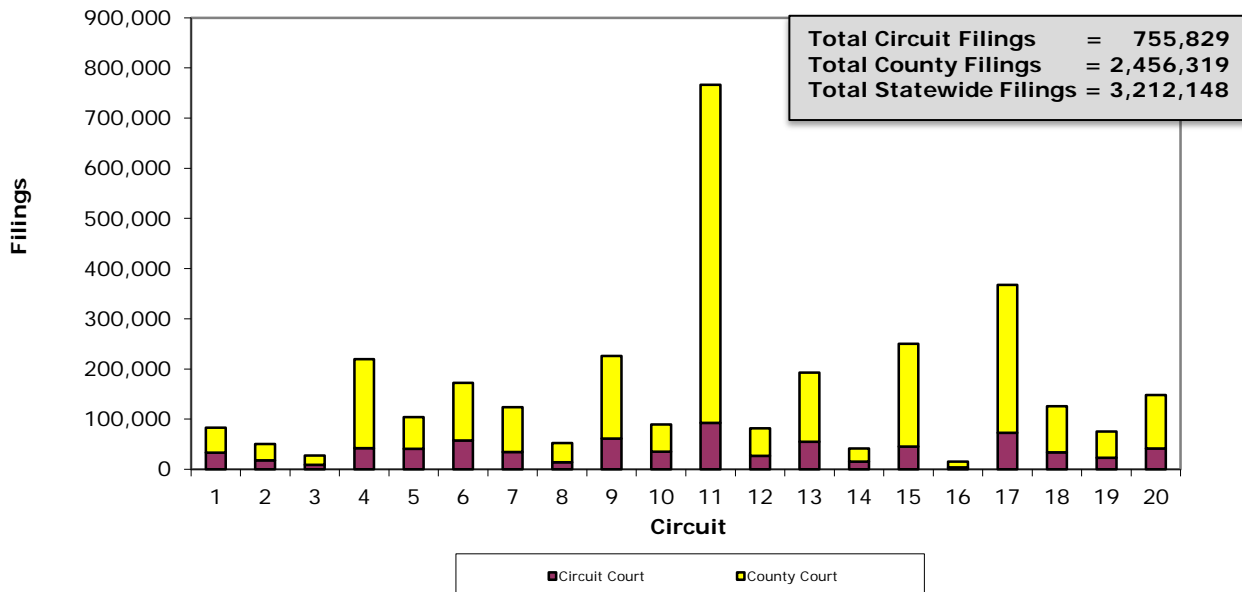

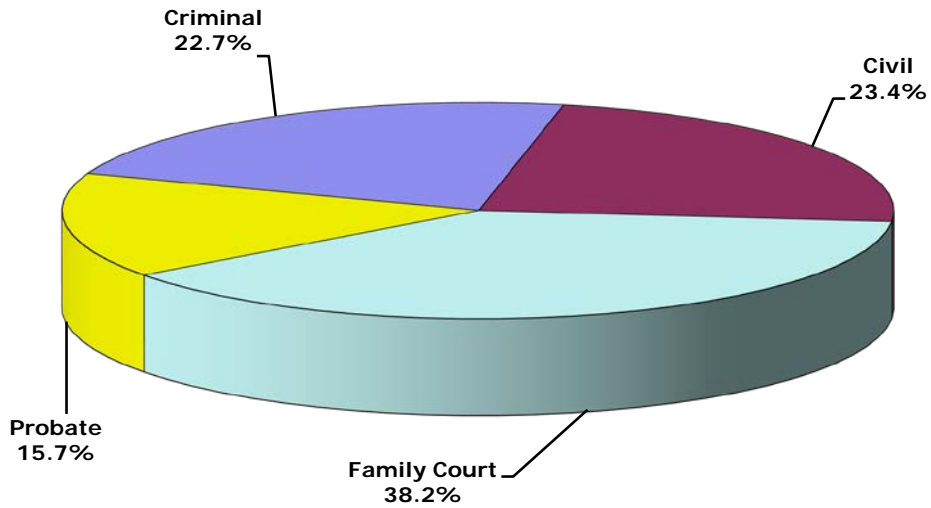

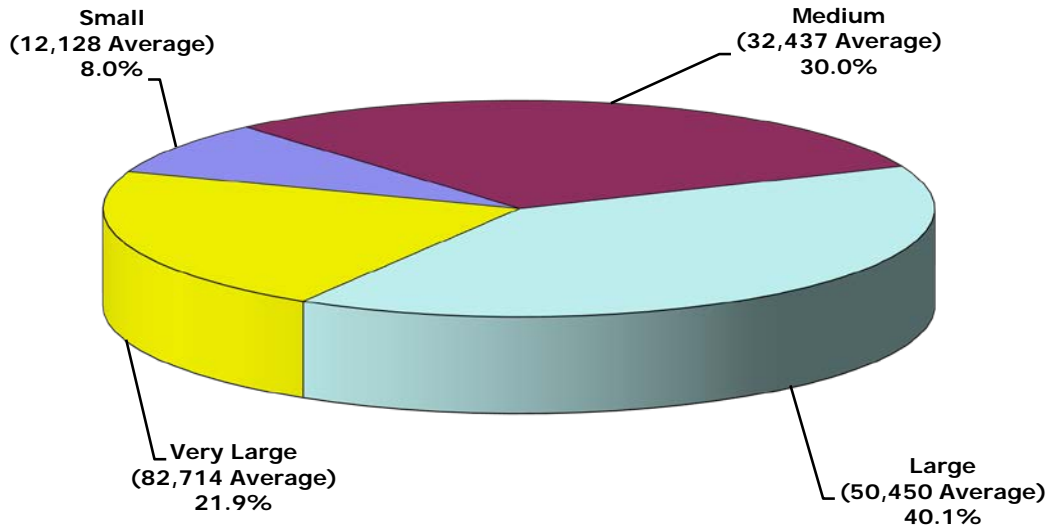

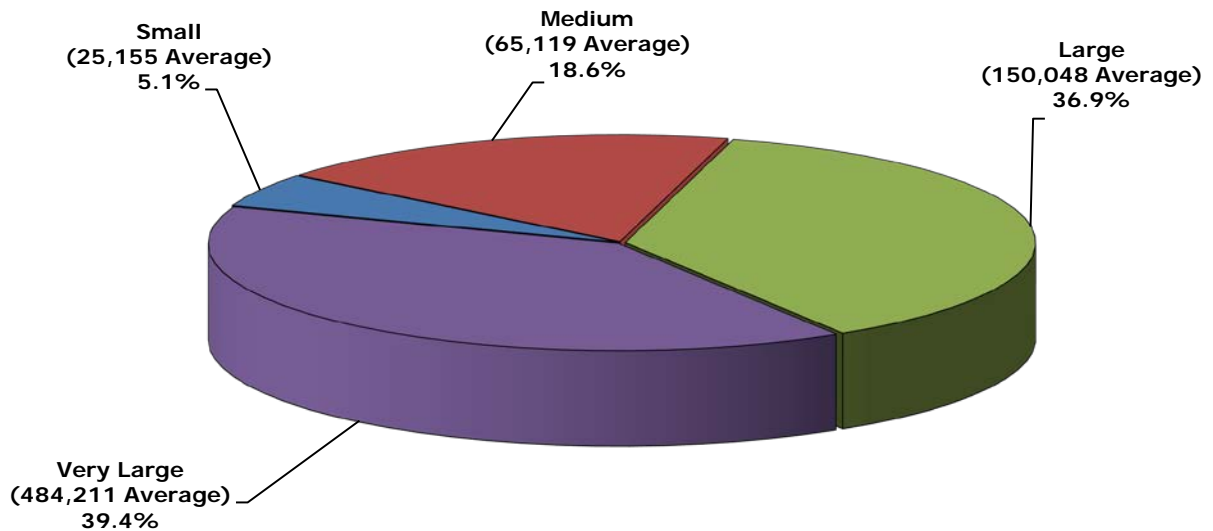

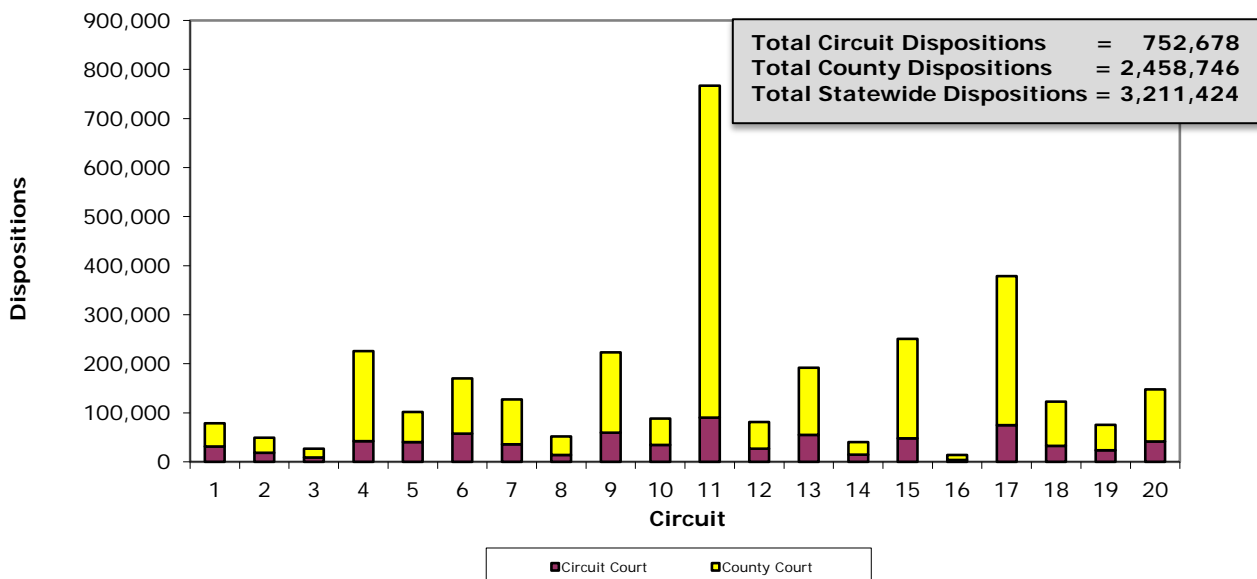

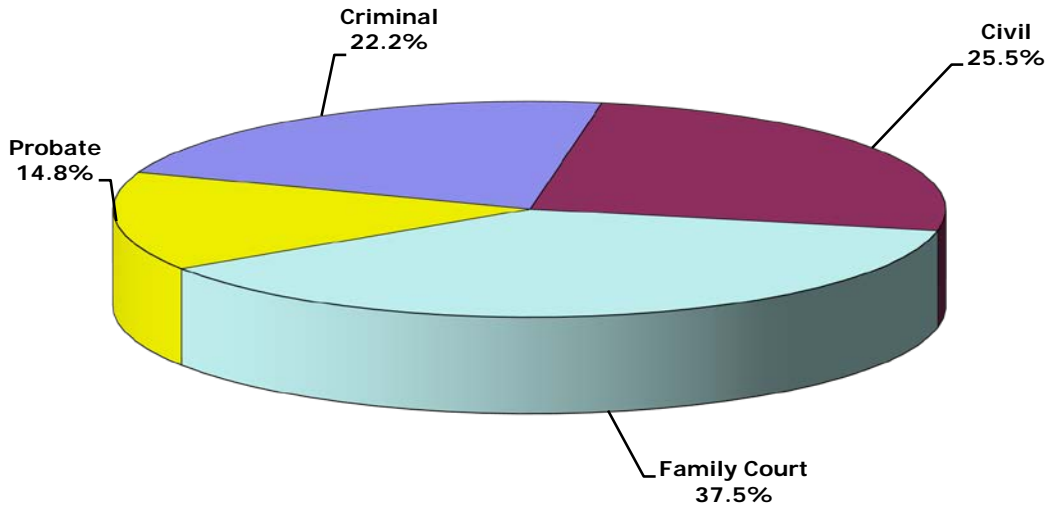

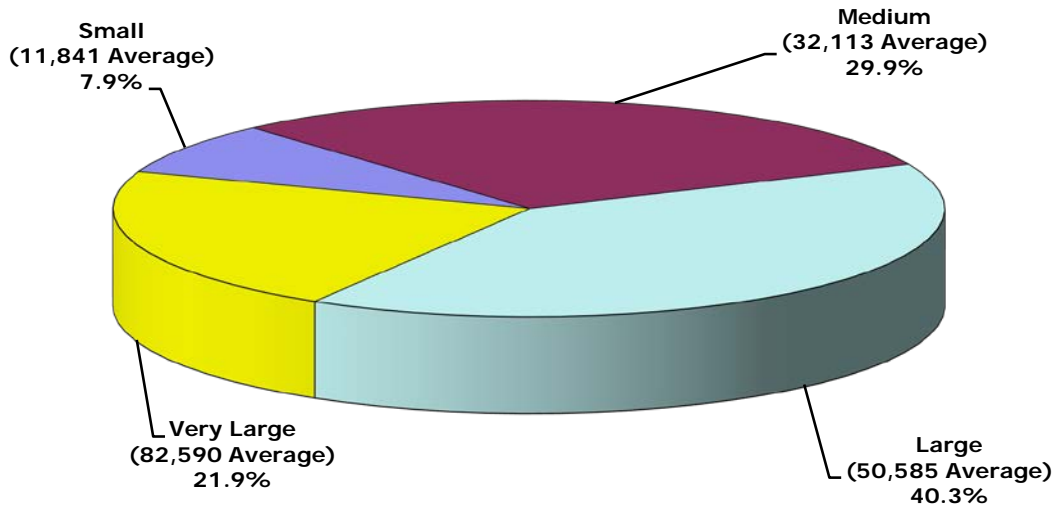

FY 2015-16



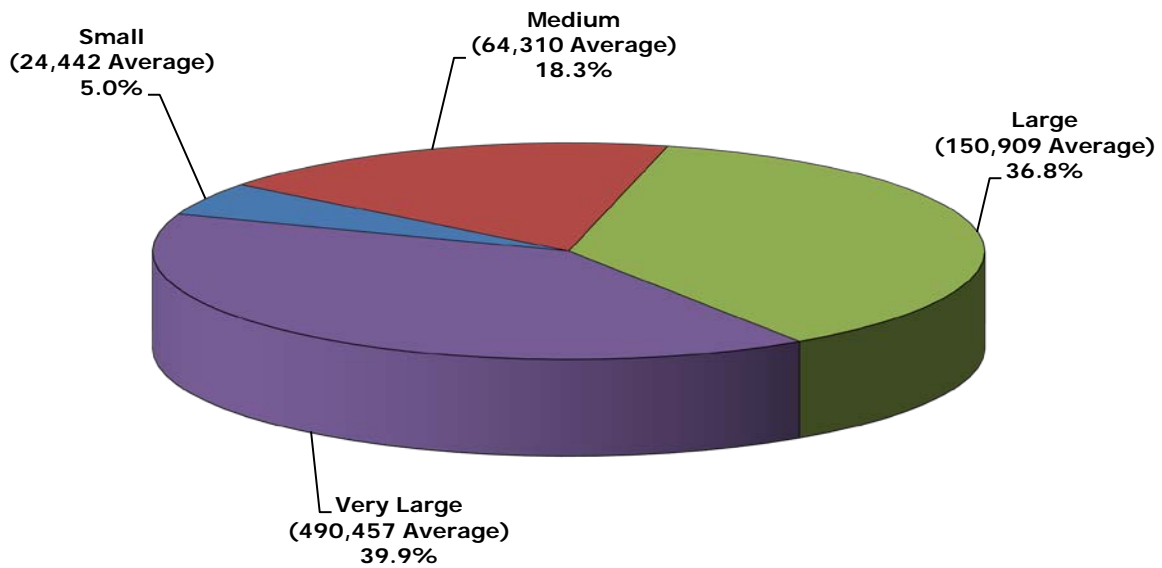
