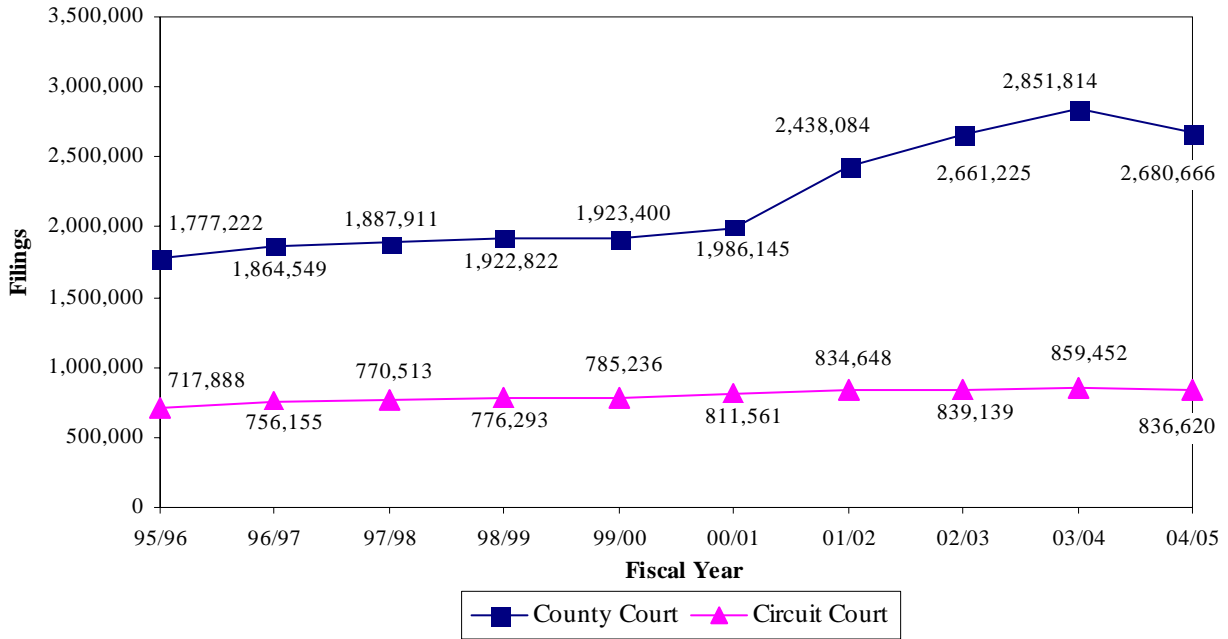

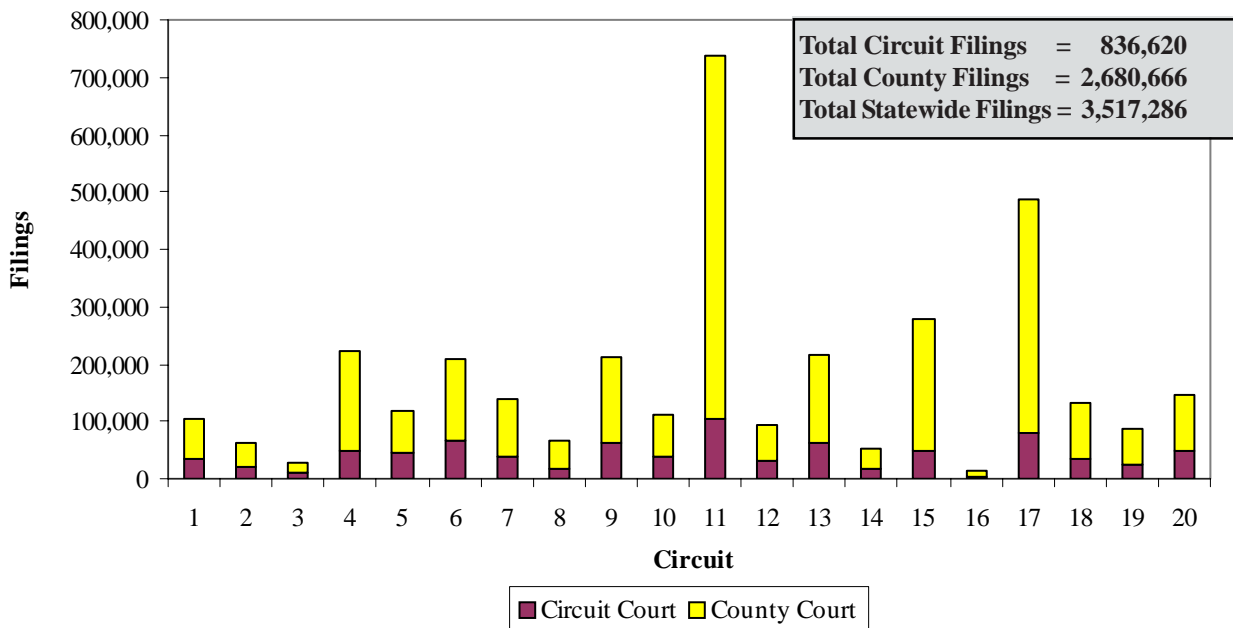
FY 1995-96 to FY 2004-05

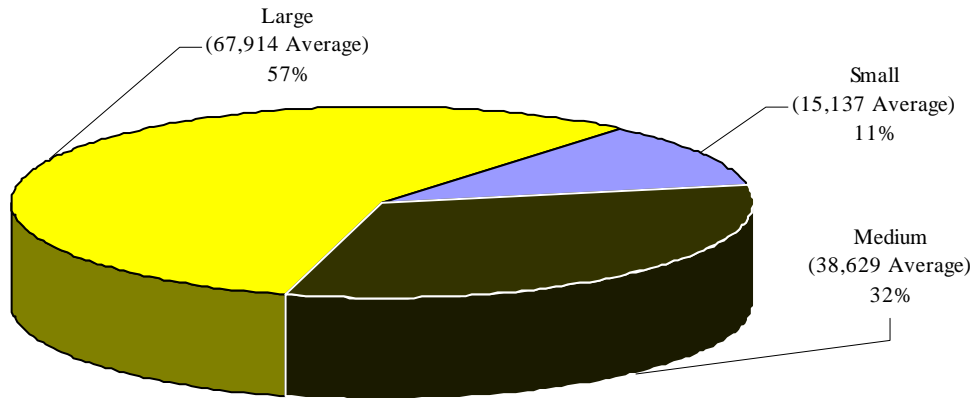

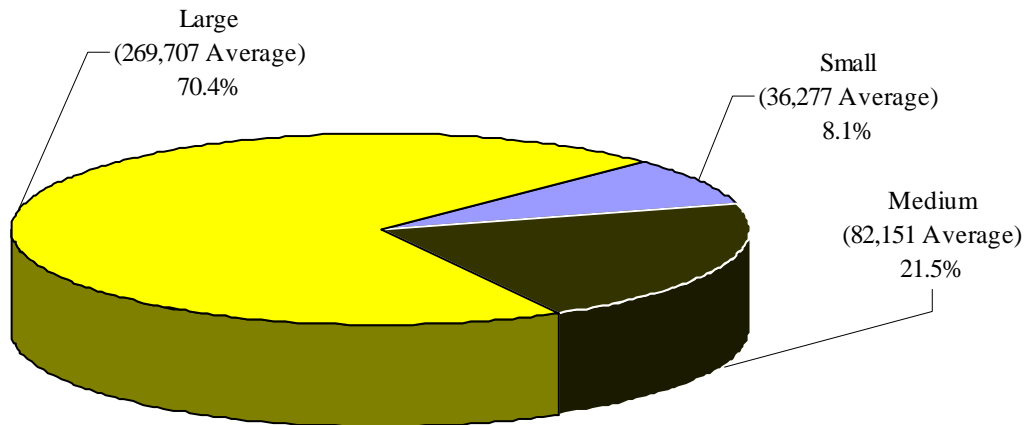

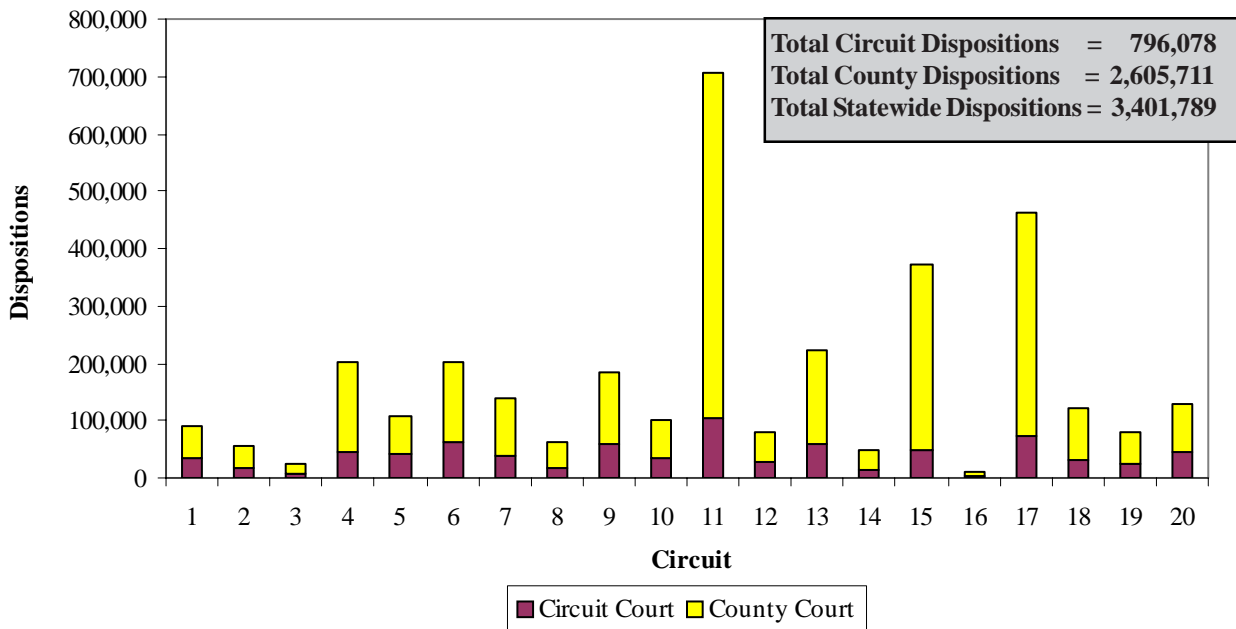

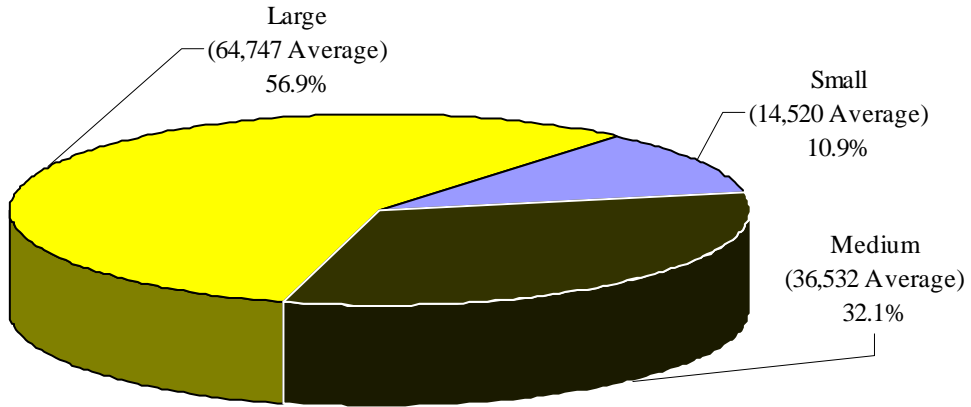

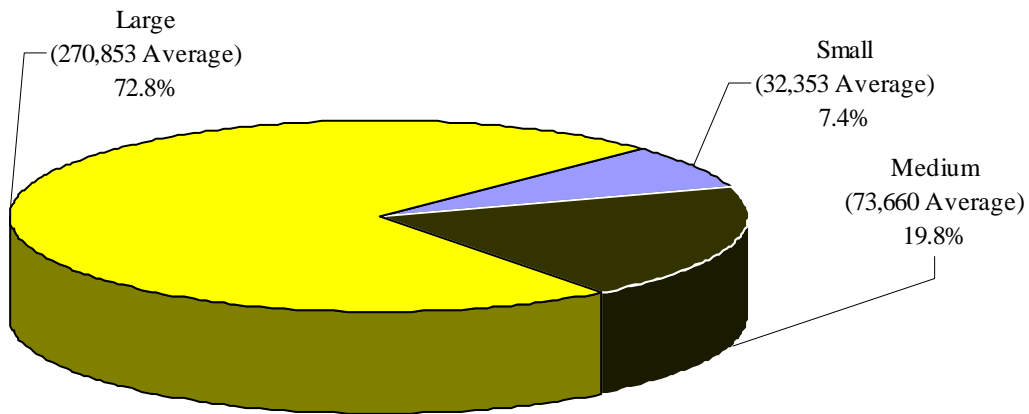
