IN RE: FLORIDA COURTS TECHNOLOGY COMMISSION

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

Originally established in 1995 as the Court Technology User's Committee, the purpose of the Florida Courts Technology Commission is to advise the Chief Justice and Supreme Court on matters relating to the use of technology in the Judicial Branch. Over the next two years, the Commission shall focus its attention on the following tasks:

1. Recommend policy governing the use of technology resources in the State Courts System.
2. Formulate priorities for appellate and trial court technology budgets and present those recommendations to the District Court of Appeal Budget Commission and the Trial Court Budget Commission.
3. Review and approve any modifications to the technical and functional standards developed by the Appellate Technology Committee and the Trial Court Technology Committee, and ensure that the technology

utilized at all levels of the State Courts System is capable of being fully integrated.

4. Evaluate strategic/operational technology plans submitted by the judicial circuits, as well as any technology plans developed by the Appellate Court Technology Committee.
5. Perform such other assignments related to the use of technology in the Judicial Branch as may be directed by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Florida.


