



Public Member Vacancy

The Florida Courts Technology Commission is responsible for overseeing, managing, and directing the development and use of technology within the judicial branch under the direction of the Supreme Court of Florida as specified in [Florida Rules of General Practice and Judicial Administration 2.236](#). The Commission is composed of 25 voting members who represent the interests of the public and the Florida courts generally rather than the separate interests of any particular district, circuit, county, division, or other organization. Members are appointed as set forth in [Florida Rules of General Practice and Judicial Administration 2.236](#). The membership consists of judges, court administrators, court technology officers, clerks of court, members of The Florida Bar, and members of the public at large. Currently, there are two public member vacancies.

The Office of the State Courts Administrator is seeking public member candidates who possess the following credentials:

- Florida resident;
- An understanding of current and emerging technology in either case management, data integration, cybersecurity, business intelligence, artificial intelligence is preferred;
- Not affiliated with any financial interest through activities of the Commission;
- Willing and able to make the time commitment to attend regularly scheduled quarterly meetings and actively participate in the Commission, workgroups, and/or subcommittees meetings;
- Not currently a judge, court staff member, clerk of court, clerk of court staff member, or member of The Florida Bar; and
- Knowledge of or experience with various court divisions, court operations, or the use of technology in the courts would be helpful.
